**Mumbai market insight: Given the competitive talent market and high counter-offer rates in BFSI and IT, it is worth negotiating a 90-day replacement guarantee (rather than the standard 30–45 days) for any mid-to-senior placement in Mumbai — early attrition is notably higher here than in any other Indian city.**

### Choosing the right agency in Mumbai:

- Sector specialisation is paramount in Mumbai — the BFSI, media, and FMCG talent markets are sufficiently niche that generalist agencies rarely deliver the calibre of candidates that a truly specialised firm can access.
- For BFSI roles, ask specifically about the consultant's personal network in your sub-sector (e.g., debt capital markets vs. retail banking) — this is a city where personal relationships with passive candidates determine search quality.
- Verify the agency's employer brand reputation with candidates — Mumbai professionals talk, and agencies known for poor communication or dishonest practices struggle to attract top-tier passive candidates to their searches.

- Never pay any fee: Mumbai's recruitment market, despite its sophistication, is not immune to fraudulent 'consultancies' that charge candidates. Legitimate agencies are always employer-paid for permanent placements — no exceptions.
